

End Of Childhood Report 2018 in numbers

The charity Save the Children surveys 195 countries every year to measure the wellbeing of children. Out of the ten worst countries to be a child eight are from Africa. The richest country in the world, the US, places only 36th. Japan ranks joint 19th with Israel and Luxembourg. Singapore and Slovenia tie in top place.
